RESOLUTION NO. 735

“WHEREAS, Section 5 of Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

“WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code) mandates that local government units are mandated to maintain peace and order and promote the safety of its inhabitants;

“WHEREAS, the personnel of the Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Philippine Army (PA) including those of the Auxiliary Police/Barangay Tanods need to enhance their skills in gun handling and this can only be realized if there is an established firing range;

“WHEREAS, practical shooting enthusiasts in the city have shown that the city can be promoted through the conduct of shooting competitions and at the same time, it can generate potential income for the city and this also necessitates the establishment of a firing range;

“WHEREAS, it is more beneficial if a permanent firing range be established;

“NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Clayborne Clyde L. Lim and duly seconded by Hon. Raul P. Martinez the Council

ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BAYAWAN CITY FIRING RANGE

Be it ordained that:

SECTION 1. Location. The firing range which will cater both to pistol and rifle shall be established at the Government Center located at Cabcabon, Barangay Banga, Bayawan City, Negros Oriental.

SECTION 2. Area. An area of eight thousand (8,000) square meters shall be designated as a firing range with a capability of around twenty (20) bays. It shall be designed to hold Level III competitions based on the International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC) standards. The actual location shall be designated by the City Engineer in accordance with the development plan of the Government Center.

SECTION 3. **Fees.** The city government through the treasurer's office shall collect a fee of one hundred pesos (₱100.00) for every individual who will make use of the range.

The management of the range may be turned over to a gun club provided the terms and conditions are favorable to the city government.

SECTION 4. **Allocation.** An initial budget of one hundred thousand pesos (₱100,000.00) shall be included in the budget for 2009 first quarter in order to establish the said firing range. The same amount shall be allocated every year until the said range is fully established.

SECTION 5. **Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or illegal by a competent court, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions.

SECTION 6. **Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.


